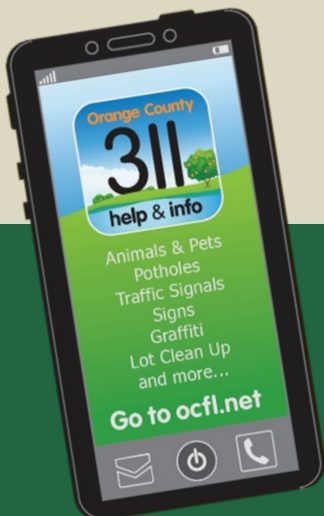

Code Compliance Question & Answer

Q: Can the County do anything if my neighbor refuses to cut their grass or keeps piles of debris in their yard?

A: Grass and weeds taller than 18 inches and the accumulation of junk, trash, and debris on a property are code violations. Please call 407-836-3111 or use the 311 app to report these code violations. If the property owner does not address the code violation, the County has the authority (with due process) to clean the property. The property owner is responsible for the cost of cleaning the property.
