

On June 11, LRSN invited Eric Grimmer, a member of Orange County's Charter Review Commission, to speak on the county-level ballot initiatives that voters will see in November. The Commission crafted these initiatives based on extensive discussion and public feedback. Voters will need to approve each initiative to pass and become part of Orange County's Charter. The proposed Charter Amendments are listed below:

- REVISE THE ORANGE COUNTY CHARTER INITIATIVE PETITION PROCESS
- REQUIRE THE CONTINUED EXISTENCE OF AN AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUND
- CHANGE THE WRITE-IN CANDIDATE EFFECT ON TIMING OF CHARTER OFFICER ELECTIONS
- REQUIRE ADOPTION OF A FISCAL SUSTAINABILITY ANALYSIS TOOL



- ESTABLISH A CHARTER OFFICE OF COUNTY ATTORNEY
- INCREASE THE NUMBER OF COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS
- CREATE A TRANSPORTATION MOBILITY ADVISORY COMMISSION
- REQUIRE A SUPERMAJORITY COUNTY COMMISSION VOTE TO DISPOSE OF OR CHANGE USE OF "COUNTY PROTECTED LANDS."
