Orlo Vista Flood Mitigation Project

Orange County's Public Works Department gave a detailed PowerPoint presentation update regarding the flood mitigation project at the Orlo Vista United Safe Neighborhood (OVUSN) Community Meeting held on May 21. Attendees asked many questions, which were answered by County Staff! Generally, this project is about 77% complete; however, due to supply-chain issues, the pump station will not be complete until Spring 2025. For now, we depend upon the existing pump station, two mobile pumps and two additional backup pumps.

This will be a place to honor God, memorialize all military, residents/nonresidents, yourself, and commemorate loved ones, family, friends, businesses, churches/places of worship, schools, service members, firefighters, law enforcement officers, medical fields, eateries, athletes, volunteers, mentors, students, nurseries, institutions, organizations, artists,

dancers, etc. All are welcome to make this goal a reality. We kept the prices reasonable per paver. The OVCofC is OUR meeting hall for Orlo Vista United Safe Neighborhood; WE volunteer our efforts in tandem! Would you like to leave a landmark brick at the OVCofC?
