## CRIME PREVENTION HOLIDAY TIPS

### PACKAGE THEFT

- Ask your delivery company to place your packages out of view
- Have a trusted neighbor pick up your packages
- Place a hold on mail delivery before going on a trip
- Take your holiday gift boxes (e.g., TV, computer, stereo, etc.) to one of the free Burglar Box Program recycle bins

### HOLIDAY SHOPPING

- Never leave gifts or valuables visible in your car
- Do not become distracted. Stay aware of your surroundings
- If it seems suspicious, Say Something
- Stay alert for vehicles that may follow you home
- Look for pedestrians at cross walks
- Do not drive impaired. Have a designated driver

## WANTED: NEIGHBORHOOD ENTRANCE SIGNS

Registration has begun for neighborhood teams to volunteer and apply for Orange County Government’s NEIGHBORHOOD BEAUTIFICATION GRANT, October 1, 2024, through May 30, 2025. This funding promotes a partnership between citizens in the County, while working to beautify the neighborhood. Grants up to \$15,000 per neighborhood are available. As active TEAMS we can enhance and define entrances to Orlo Vista’s many established subdivisions, including those with mid-20<sup>th</sup> Century homes! We had unwelcome encounters with two major hurricanes – Helene and Milton. These passes made us more aware of the need to keep our storm drains cleared, and that nothing should be placed upon or at the curbside manholes. **Contact Orange County 3-1-1 (407-836-3111)** when you think that Roads and Drainage needs to clean out silt buildup. WE DON'T NEED ANY STREET FLOODING.

The auxiliary pumps worked effectively for the Orlo Vista Flood Mitigation Project’s retention ponds. The main pump station will be complete in Spring 2025.
